- 1. Applicant must post a \$1500 cash bond with the application. Upon completion of the proposed activity and Town acceptance, the applicant may request return of the bond.
- 2. Contractor/ applicant must contact call before you dig 1-800-922-4455, CBYD number must be recorded on permit application before it can be approved.
- 3. Notice must be provided 48 hrs. prior to the start of work in the Town right of way. Proprosed driveway clearly marked prior to notification.
- 4. Soil erosion & sedimentation control shall conform to the Towns Technical Standards.
- 5. Work shall be constructed in compliance with the Towns Standards. Proposed installation shall not disturb existing drainage features or alter runoff impacting Town/ private properties. Installation shall maintain surface runoff to the associated gutter areas and permit free flow no obstructions. If required associated pipe shall be a minimum 15" reinforced concrete pipe or an approved equivalent.
- 6. Proposed installation will not impact the passage of traffic or interfere with associated snow removal activities of the Town of Stonington.
- 7. All work, associated permits, materials and construction activities within the Towns Right of Way shall be at the owner's expense.
- 8. A minimum of 10' bituminous concrete (minimum 12' maximum 16' width) shall be constructed at the driveway entrance/ town road (2" compacted asphalt/ 6" processed gravel base) or other materials as approved by the Director of Public Works or designee.
- 9. All disturbed areas within the Towns Right of Way shall be restored and accepted by the Town.

- 10. Applicant agrees that all work will be performed in accordance to rules, regulations and standards of the local agency and state. Applicant shall indemnify, defendant hold the local agency, it's officers, agents and employees harmless from any and all claims, suits, liability, including but not limited to, litigation costs and attorney's fees which the local agency may incur as a result of any claims and suits for personal injury, property damage or inverse condemnation by reason of the applicant's placement of/ or maintenance of ROW improvements authorized by the permit.
- 11. Applicant shall be solely responsible for the repair and safe condition/ maintenance of all improvements in the Towns Right of Way.
