2. New Business: Meet and confer with the Board of Selectmen pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § CGS 7-191 (c) regarding:
 - a. The Board of Selectmen's recommendation to the Charter Revision Commission that it amend Section 10-3(B) of the proposed revised Charter to read as follows: "To establish the staggered terms for the Board of Finance and increase the membership of the Board of Finance to seven members, the following process shall be followed. For the 2017 town election, three positions will be filled pursuant to the election procedures contained in this Charter, except that one of said positions shall be for a term of two years for the 2017 election only."
 - b. The Board of Selectmen's recommendation to the Charter Revision Commission that it amend Section 6-5(C) of the proposed revised Charter to reference the Board of Finance rather than the Board of Education.
 - c. The Board of Selectmen's recommendation to the Charter Revision Commission that it amend Section 8-2(B) (Department of Assessment) of the proposed revised Charter so that the last sentence of the first paragraph reads: "The Department shall have the following duties in addition to any powers set forth under Section 10-4 of this Charter."
