SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
February 10, 2015

A Special Town Meeting of the Town of Stonington was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on February 10, 2015 at the Stonington High School auditorium, 176 South Broad St., Pawcatuck, CT, by First Selectman George Crouse. Also, in attendance were Selectmen Rob Simmons and Michael Spellman.

Eric Janney was nominated for Moderator by Rob Simmons, seconded by Bill Sternberg and was unanimously elected Moderator of the meeting. Town Clerk, Cynthia Ladwig served as Clerk.

There being no objection the Moderator dispensed with the reading of the Call of the meeting, recorded immediately preceding these minutes.

The Moderator asked for a motion on the first item on the Call. First Selectman Crouse presented and read the following resolution:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF STONINGTON IN LAWFUL MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED:

To consider and vote on a resolution to approve the Board of Finance's approval of a request in the amount of \$125,000.00 from Stonington Public Schools for security items for the Town's elementary schools.

Being properly seconded, the Moderator opened the floor to discussion. Selectman Rob Simmons spoke in favor of the resolution. The Moderator asked for a vote on the resolution. The resolution passed by a unanimous voice vote.

The Moderator asked for a motion on the second item on the Call. First Selectman Crouse presented and read the following resolution:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF STONINGTON IN LAWFUL MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED:


To consider and vote on a resolution to approve the Board of Finance's approval of a \$40,000.00 increase to the Building Department's "technical assistance" line item to pay for the services of a part time building inspector.

Being properly seconded, the Moderator opened the floor to discussion. First Selectman Crouse read excerpts from the Building Officials memo presented to the Board of Finance. Hearing no further discussion, the Moderator asked for a vote on the resolution. The resolution passed by unanimous voice vote.

Being no further business on the Call of the Town Meeting, the Moderator declared the meeting adjourned at 7:08 p.m.
