

**2014 Plan of Conservation and Development Subcommittee
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 2, 2014**

The 2014 Plan of Conservation and Development Subcommittee of the Planning and Zoning Commission held a Regular Meeting on June 2, 2014 7:00PM at the Stonington Police Department Meeting Room - 173 S. Broad St. Pawcatuck.

Attending were members Bob Birmingham, Wendy Bury, Walter Grant, Sara Lathrop, Bill Lyman and Bob Mohr. Planning and Zoning Commission members, Ben Tamsky and Curtis Lynch, and Town Planner, Keith A. Brynes, were also in attendance.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lathrop at 7:05PM.

Minutes:

Mr. Lyman motioned to approve the minutes of the 5/5/14 meeting; seconded by Mr. Birmingham. The motion was unanimously approved.

New Business:

Discussion of June 30th Public Informational Meeting.

Mr. Brynes discussed planning for the June 30th public informational meeting at Stonington High School. Members asked Mr. Brynes to send Planimetrics comments received prior to the meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to gather input on the draft plan and not to debate issues. Over the next few weeks staff will advertise the meeting through a press release and notice on the town's website. Written comment sheets will be available for members of the public who do not wish to speak. The Subcommittee agreed that July 7th will be the cut-off date for public comment after the meeting so that input can be discussed by the Subcommittee and revisions to the plan can be made.


Discussion of comments received on draft plan.
