- Discussed the town 2012/3 Hazard Mitigation Plan Update and the need to incorporate sea level rise in the 2017 update.
- Reviewed maps of Study Area # 1. Discussed the need for economic impact data. Representatives from Dewberry Consulting described what types of assistance they have rendered to other towns and general GIS capabilities. Scot Deledda will contact town's GIS contractor to see what they are capable of. Task force members thought that such things as adding SLR to FEMA flood maps and storm event scenarios to SLR would be beneficial. Reviewed measurable SLR factors – task force members will each compile priority rating list prior to next meeting.
