MEETING MINUTES

1) Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance

Chair Olsson called the meeting to order at 5:00PM.

2) Remarks of Visitors

Hartford Marathon Group – Request for ½ Marathon

Barry Saluk, Mystic, CT

In attendance to support race with Hartford Marathon Foundation scheduled for June 28th at 7am behind Olde Mistick Village.

Stephen Bessette, Mystic, CT

In attendance to request that the Commission support proposed race with Hartford Marathon Foundation & the Mystic Rotary.

Chair Olsson requested the Commission address agenda item 4a at this time.

4. Traffic

a. Hartford Marathon Group – Request for ½ Marathon

Josh Miller, Technical Director, Hartford Marathon Foundation

Provided map of proposed course route, route impact chart & liability insurance examples; excited about partnership with Mystic Rotary & hopes the Commission will decide to support.

Chief Stated he met with Rotary and Hartford Marathon Foundation & is extremely impressed with organization & professionalism.

Chair Olsson asked how long Route 27 will be shut down.

Mr. Miller stated that the first runner will be off Route 27 by 7:05am & last runner by 7:15am; just over 20 minutes before Route 27 is cleared. Anticipate shutting road down completely.

Chief stated Route 27 will be shut down for approximately 15-20 minutes starting at 7am. Hartford Marathon Foundation providing approximately 120 volunteers & will have to hire officers.

4. Traffic

a. Hartford Marathon Group – Request for ½ Marathon

Commissioner Trebisacci is very concerned about the impact on the residents, & does not feel comfortable approving without resident input. He asked the Chief if there is procedure in place to get input from residents & businesses.

Chief Stewart explained that the Police Commission meeting is the forum for residents & businesses to discuss these issues.

Vice-Chair Moukawsher asked about scope.

Mr. Miller stated about 1,000 participants, possibly 2,000 people including observers, etc., parking at Old Mistick Village & The Mystic Aquarium.

Vice-Chair Moukawsher asked if the organizers had consulted businesses on the opposite side (south side) of Coogan Blvd. Vice-Chair Moukawsher stated that he did not want a large number of people coming to the Commission and complaining after the fact that they did not have access to their property or that their businesses suffered. Mr. Moukawsher was in favor of the event but agreed with Commissioner Trebisacci that surrounding property owners should be given sufficient notice and have input.

- Commissioner Trebisacci made a motion to table discussion until the next meeting in January, to allow for notification of area residents and business owners. Motion seconded by Vice-Chair Moukawsher, all in favor, motion approved.

Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center Special Use Permit

Chad Frost, Architect

In attendance on behalf of Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center regarding their application for a special use permit to rehabilitate existing site. Improvements include parking, sidewalks, trails, indoor and outdoor educational areas, and event spaces.

Vice-Chair Moukawsher stated he is concerned with parking & event capacities.

Chief Stewart stated that at the last event there were complaints related to parking, from both businesses & residents, as well as CL&P regarding their access road, and the Department had to handle phone calls that came in.

Mr. Frost stated that placing signage during events will help, but all parking issues are taken seriously and will be addressed.

- A motion was made by Vice-Chair Moukawsher that the Commission reply to the Planning and Zoning Commission that Commissioners expressed some safety and traffic concerns and recommended that they give consideration to future demands for parking especially during special events. Specifically the Police Commission would recommend that they consider requiring that the north entrance be marked for entrance only and that vehicles be allowed to enter and exit the property from the south driveway. Additionally, it is recommended that final approval be contingent upon the applicant obtaining all necessary state approvals for their use on Rt.27. Motion seconded by Commissioner Trebisacci, Commissioner Rotella abstained. Motion carried.

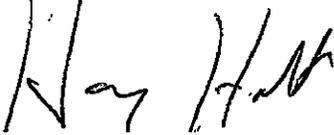
A motion was made by Commissioner Holt to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion seconded by Vice-Chair Moukawsher, all in favor, motion approved.
