Request – Use of Public Works Parking Lot

- Ms. Downie gave an overview on a meeting with the Mystic Seaport who shared their plan to become carbon neutral and how the Boathouse project will help in this effort including areas such as the living shoreline and green infrastructure. The remediation specs for the Boathouse Park will be forthcoming. She attended a meeting with DEEP regarding close out reports for underground storage tanks. She noted how nice it was for the Board to participate in Stonington High School graduation.
- Ms. Strunk stated that the swearing in ceremony for the new police officers was a nice event and very welcoming to the new officers.
- Ms. Chesebrough gave an overview stating that Town received a Brownfield Assessment grant for 21 Pawcatuck Ave. She noted a bio-retention pond is being built at Spellman Park Tennis Courts which will help with stormwater run-off and showcase the Town's MS4 work. She noted that she expects to hear back from the DOT soon about the viaduct project after the Town and Borough shared concerns about the project.
