a) READCO representative, Jeremy Browning, Managing Director and Member of TRIO Properties LLC, a partner with READCO for the development of the former movie theater parcel, corner of RT 2 and Voluntown Road, known as 85 Voluntown Road. Jeremy presented renditions of the master plan for the property. READCO is applying to the Planning & Zoning Commission for a Neighborhood Design District and then will apply for approval of their site plan. Plans are to redevelop the former theater into indoor pickelball courts along with some outdoor courts and 124 residential rental housing units of various sizes. The plan shows 10,000 square feet of commercial space which could incorporate the existing commercial use on the site. READCO has owned this site for 25 years. TRIO is the managing company for the Harbor Heights development. Discussion followed.
