Penalties for False Stateme A person is guilty of false st application for an absence	mts tatement in absentee balloting when he intentionally makes a false written statement in or ballot or the inner envelope accompanying any such ballot, which he does not believe to i	on or signs the nan	ne of another per	son to the

application for an assence value or the inner envelope accompanying any such value, which he was not velocite to be true and which statement or organizers in intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his official function. False statement in absentee balloting is a class D felony. The sentence for a class D felony shall be at least one year but may not exceed five years in prison. A fine for the conviction of a class D felony shall not exceed five thousand dollars.

This application is to be returned to municipal clerk of municipality in which you are a registered voter. Absentee ballot sets are to be provided by the municipal clerk beginning 31 days before an election, 21 days before a primary, or 19 days before a referendum, upon application properly made. Blank ballots may be sent out to certain military persons beginning 90 days before a regular election and to Connecticut electors temporarily residing outside the U.S. and all military persons beginning approximately 45 days before a regular election, approximately 30 days before a primary and as soon as a complete list of candidates and questions is available before a madel election. special election.
