

Members of the Board, please find attached, my request for my departmental year end transfers. At this time, I am requesting just the one line-item transfer for the following reason.

We estimate the account 10152-80262 (Commercial Collections/Willimantic Waste) will have a shortfall of \$51,000 for end of year. We feel the tonnage is up due to COVID restrictions being lifted and folks are eager to get out and visit restaurants and brick and mortar stores. After a hiatus during the last 2 years, businesses are more or less returning to normal.

We estimate the account 10152-80260 (SCRRRA Disposal Fees/residential MSW) to have a surplus of approximately \$56,000. Again, for perhaps the same reason, fewer people are working from home or staying home due to COVID concerns and are back to work and eating out.

Therefore, we would like to move \$51,000 from 10152-80260 to account 10152-80262.
