Stonington Harbor Management Ordinance proposed revision

Section 6 F

F. Commercial Moorings. Commercial moorings shall be limited to a maximum of 35 percent of the total deep draft moorings in the harbor. The Harbor Management Commission may modify this percentage.

Change to:

F. Commercial Moorings. Commercial moorings shall be limited to a maximum of 35 percent of the total deep draft moorings in the harbor. The Harbor Management Commission may modify this percentage. Commercial Moorings shall also be limited to placement in special anchorage areas as defined by CFR Title 33 Chapter 1, Subchapter 1 Anchorages, Part 110 Anchorage Regulations, Subpart A Special Anchorage Areas, 110.50 Stonington Harbor , Conn.
