No Special Olympics Sailing Regatta in September this year due to Covid-19 restrictions.

Discussed addition of a buoy or daymark (piling) at end of rock groin at tip of Pawcatuck Point (Osbrook Point) with USCG ATON group. They said adding a USCG buoy could take years and suggested a 'private aid to navigation' instead. I contacted Seaport Marine Construction and asked their opinion of installing a wood or steel piling at that location. They have given a rough estimate of \$3500 +/- to install a steel piling. I submitted an application to CT DEEP for a daymark. Hope to meet with DEEP later this month for on water review.

I was informed by SPD of a "concert" that would possibly happen at Sandy Point 9/7/2020. This was an "event" that had originally been planned for Napatree beach. RI informed the organizers that under current restrictions it would not be permitted. CT relayed the same sentiment to the organizers. The "event" was scaled down to 4 performers on individual vessels playing live music over the course of the day.

Approximately 125 vessels anchored in the area. All remained clear of the channel with some minor "coaching". Westerly PD, RI DEM and USCG all made passes though the area with no complaints about traffic.

Transient dingy dock has had a few reports of dingys staying tied for extended periods due to increased usage of the transient anchorage area. Owners identified and vessels removed.
