Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk's office during normal business hours beginning on Monday, September 13, 2021.

The first item on the Special Town Meeting called for Monday, September 27, 2021 set forth in the warning of said meeting is as follows:

A resolution to adopt an Ordinance of the Town of Stonington, Connecticut, prohibiting the establishment of a Cannabis Establishment within the Town Limits. "SHALL THE TOWN OF STONINGTON ADOPT AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS?"

Those voting to prohibit a cannabis establishment will vote "YES". Those voting to allow a cannabis establishment will vote "NO".
