Thank you to Debbie Downie and Nick Kepple for meeting with me last week in anticipation of the upcoming meeting of the committee. Based on the last meeting of the full committee we have procured the Remedial Action Plan and the Aquatic Vegetation Study and added those expenses to our accounting tasks. These work products been completed and as of this afternoon I have received the SAV. Pursuant to the committee's request at the July meeting, we have put together actions to expend the rest of the assessment grant and finish as many tasks associated with furthering the permitting to bring the project forward to be as shovel ready as possible. At the chairman's request we are waiting until the committee convenes to make a final determination of the priority items to expend our grant funding.

These may include:

Stadia	Task 1 Permitting	\$11,000.00

These items total: \$49,925.00

The Finance Director has stated that, "there is \$58,000 left in the brownfield grant before the \$3,500 for the SAV study. And Kent and Frost still has \$27,213 left on its contract including the SAV study."

My opinion is that we should head forward as quickly as possible with the above referenced items. The consensus of the committee on this path would be appreciated before the Town expends more funds on its behalf.
