On March 19th at 10:30am The Cultural District Commission will welcome representatives from the Department of Economic and Community Development to assess our application for Cultural District designation.

We have applied to become the State's first town with TWO cultural districts- Mystic Bridge and Stonington Village.

If successful, we begin to strategically assess how our corner of the State can best serve the residents-current and future-, our visitors, our businesses, and the overall sustainable development of our blessings.

Government and Civic leaders have been cordially invited to join The Commission on some or all of our walking tour, beginning at 10:30am from the Mystic Seaport Museum's south entrance courtyard.

Mystic Bridge loop: Proceed to Holmes St, past the Bascule Bridge and onto Cottrell St, looping via Washington to Broadway to Willow to Greenmanville and then back to the south parking lot.

Stonington Village Loop: Proceed to Stonington Point and walk the village up Water St to Wadawanuck Square and back via Main St.

We finish going to the Velvet Mill sculpture garden and conclude with a reception at Zest Bakery. Our goal is to be at Zest by 1:45pm.
