Stonington Village Loop:
 Proceed to Stonington Point and walk the village up Water St to Wadawanuck Square and back via Main St.

We finish going to the Velvet Mill sculpture garden and conclude with a reception at Zest Bakery. Our goal is to be at Zest by 1:45pm.
