VIRTUAL ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING April 19, 2021

First Selectman Danielle Chesebrough called the virtual Annual Town Budget Meeting of the Town of Stonington to order at 5:31 p.m. on April 19, 2021. Attending were First Selectman Danielle Chesebrough and Selectwomen June Strunk and Deb Downie.

Selectwoman Deb Downie nominated Mr. Ted Ladwig as Moderator. Being properly seconded by Selectwoman June Strunk and hearing no objections Mr. Ladwig was unanimously elected Moderator of the meeting, and Town Clerk Cynthia Ladwig served as clerk of the meeting.

There being no objection, the Moderator dispensed with reading the Call recorded immediately preceding these pages and asked for a resolution on the first item on the Call.

First Selectman Chesebrough moved and read the following resolution:
