## FINAL MINUTES Regular Meeting Wednesday, November 20, 2019

Human Services Building 166 South Broad Street, Pawcatuck, CT

Attending: EDC: Dave Hammond, Kevin Bowdler, Jim Lathrop, Suzanne Lane, Rich Balestracci, Pete Robinson, Bill Hobbs; Department of Planning: Keith Brynes; Guest: Fran Hoffman, Lisa Konecki.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

The Minutes of the October 16, 2019 Regular Meeting were approved. Motion: Jim, Second: Kevin. All in Favor.

Old Business – See Table for Plan status updates of 2019-20 Projects. Projects discussed:

- a) Project #1: Grain Property *Action*: Dave to seek outside facilitator for Community Conversation; follow-up on street view deliverable. *Action*: Jim to draft an RFQ for site survey, specifically to define abutting Amtrak property. Authorized \$1,000 for street view conceptual drawing (Azzinaro) and up to \$1,000 for facilitator for Jan 14 "downtown vision" Community Conversation and meeting materials. *Motion*: Jim; Second: Pete; All in Favor.
- Project #2: Pawcatuck Historic Structure designation research by AHS underway.
- c) Project #3: Circus Lot Cleanup Day set for Dec 14, 10 a.m.-12noon. Authorized \$350 for cleanup Day dumpster. **Motion**: Dave; Second: Kevin; **All in Favor.**
- d) Project #4: Pawcatuck Riverwalk bi-weekly citizen's committee meetings are ongoing. *Action*: Dave to work with Town Hall to find budget for Docko conceptual plans and permitting proposal. Authorized \$300 for conceptual drawing of riverwalk section from Donahue Park to Route 1 bridge. *Motion*: Kevin; Second: Pete; All in Favor, Abstained: Jim.
- e) Project #'s 6 and 7: Branding and Wayfinding. Working with David Lattizori, BoPC, and DPW to have Coogan Blvd wayfinding signs made and installed, expressly to help people to find the new Hartford Health Care medical center but to include other attractions as well; next Stonington Magazine article submission date is Feb 1; Action: Kevin to set editorial calendar (topics and authors).
- f) Project #'s 8-11: All Housing theme projects were deferred.

## **New Business:**

a) Jim and Dave to draft proposal for PV-5 amendment to allow density bonus for larger "back-lots", i.e. exempt from 1/3 commercial requirement. Would only apply to three properties: Grain, Circus lot, Jameson Ct.

- Agreed to partner with the SECT Cultural Coalition to host a partner event to explore establishing a Cultural District in Stonington.
   Motion: Dave; Second: Kevin; All in Favor.
- c) Kevin presented an economic cluster analysis of the Grand List.
- d) The DOP CIP package will be distributed to the EDC. *Action*: decide highest priority projects to show support to BOS and BOF.
- e) Agreed to hold a joint-EDC meeting with Westerly to explore river-related joint projects, such as a Riverwalk and pedestrian bridge. *Action*: Dave to set up.
- f) Conduct Phase 1 Environmental Assessment study of Circus Lot. Authorized \$2,275 ref: Kropp June 28 quote. **Motion**: Jim; Second: Kevin; **All in Favor.**

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
