The Stonington Facilities Committee held a regular meeting on this date, Tuesday, March 10, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. at Stonington Human Services Building Community Room.

1. Call to Order

Chairman Sartor called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

- Status

Chairman Sartor said the public works department wants to keep this as a town building. The committee discussed the Inland Intervention for Coastal Resilience in Mystic, Connecticut report created by Conway School's Graduate Program in Sustainable Landscape Planning and Design, Winter 2019, that specifically mentions a use for the Fourth District Voting Hall property. The committee discussed various possible uses for the property. The flooding of the property and possible solutions was discussed. Chairman Sartor said the committee suggestion of use will be dependent on whether the property will be mitigated for flooding.

8. Town-Wide Facilities Review

Chairman Sartor said he had a meeting with Barbara McKrell, Stonington Director of Public Works and Tom Curioso, Stonington Highway Division to visit the public works facility for the town-wide facilities review and get some input on the Fourth District voting hall. Chairman Sartor said the public works department is interested in the 49 North Stonington Road building for storage. Chairman Sartor asked the public works department to write something up outlining how they would best use that space. Chairman Sartor said taking this thought further, the town hall also needs space for storage of records. Chris Donahue shared lists of the town hall departments to the committee. To continue the town-wide needs review, a questionnaire will be developed by the committee and sent to the Danielle Chesebrough, Stonington First Selectmen, for approval to be distributed to town departments to determine their needs for space.

There weren't any public comments.


11. Comments from the Committee
