
Commissioner Elmer made a motion to exit the executive session. Motion seconded by Commissioner Turner, all in favor, motion approved.

Chairman O'Shaughnessy stated that the Board of Police Commissioners has conducted the interviews of the candidates for police officer for the Town of Stonington and that the Board has come to the following consensus, which was read by Chief Stewart: Conditional offers to the following three candidates, 1. Christopher Appleton, 2. Kevin Warmley, and 3. Thomas Marsh. Conditional upon successful completion of all background requirements. Furthermore, these three candidates will be considered hired with less seniority than the certified officer candidates to be interviewed next week, or at a time in the near future. Also, candidates Scannelli, Bryan and Wallace are all placed on a stand-by list, in this order. If any of the candidates listed above do not meet requirements, the candidates on stand-by will be inserted into the process for immediate hire. Vice Chairman Tabor made a motion to approve the consensus read by Chief Stewart. Motion seconded by Commissioner Elmer, all in favor, motion approved.
