The have outlined five concerns: Blocking of Signage, Parking, Security, Fire Department Access, and sidewalk buckling. Ayo Bryant suggested only some trees be removed. Discuss that this included 36 trees and the committee will hold a special meeting in the spring to walk the concerned area to develop a plan.
