- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m.
- Minutes from previous meetings were approved with no additions or corrections: January 17, 2018 Regular Meeting; Special Meetings: January 16, 2018; January 17, 2018 Branding / Wayfinding subcommittee; January 29, 2018 Aquaculture Forum; January 31, 2018 and February 14, 2018 TIF subcommittee; February 8, 2018 Liberty St subcommittee. Motion: Pete; Second: Kevin; All in Favor.
- 3. Comments from the Public
  - Harrison Macris gave an overview of plans for the Armory building to house his fabrication business as well as provide incubator space for fledgling technology entrepreneurs. He will submit a change of use application at the March 20, 2018 PZC meeting. Motion to provide a Letter of Support: Dave; Second: Pete; Seven in Favor, one abstain. Action: Pete to draft Letter, send to Dave.
- 4. Guest Speaker: Wendy Bury, Executive Director, Southeastern CT Cultural Coalition (CC) gave a presentation that highlighted how arts and culture drive economic development. The CC has launched a Cultural Landscape Initiative to build a database of cultural assets (see item 5f, below). Other areas for collaboration include grants, networking, connecting businesses to the arts.
- 5. Old Business:
  - a) EDC-sponsored Community Conversations Several property owners in (one of eight) GC-60 zones would like to see contemporized zoning regulations to promote mixed-use, specifically to include housing. Action: Kevin to invite property owners to an EDC meeting to present their ideas.
  - b) EDC subcommittee structure: Subcommittees come to full EDC for decisions; brief subcommittee agendas and minutes can summarize meeting purpose and outcome. Two or more EDC members in attendance constitutes a public meeting; per FOI submit Agenda at least 24 hours prior to meeting, Minutes within 7 days (send to Cheryl Sadowski at Town Hall)
  - c) Agriculture Committee Report: A debrief of the 2/13/18 Agriculture subcommittee meeting was provided. The EDC is sponsoring a PA490 Information Forum on Feb 26. Motion to authorize \$100 for LaGrua rental: Ward; Second: Kevin; All in Favor.

- d) Aquaculture Community Education Forum: A report out of the 1/29/18 highly-informative shellfish industry Education Forum was given; next steps to support this initiative are TBD. No actions or decisions.
- e) **Branding / Placemaking / Wayfinding –** Branding effort continues, web design and content for economic clusters are in the planning phase. **Motion** to purchase banner with new Stonington logo and aerial backdrop for \$235: Kevin; **Second**: Dave; **All in Favor**. The banner can be used for any ED-related purpose.
- f) Cultural Asset Inventory Initiative Jake Mueller, a Stonington High School senior in the school's Internship program, has begun to develop a database of cultural assets (see also Guest Speaker, above). No actions or decisions.
- g) Marinas economic cluster EDC presence (banner included) at a table at the Hartford Boat Show (Feb 5-8) brought visibility to marinas in Stonington.
   Motion for \$95 for electricity to run Stonington Marinas Three Harbors video loop: Kevin; Second: Dave; All in Favor
- h) **Liberty St subcommittee** Initial meeting held Feb 8; subcommittee still in planning phase. Next meeting is Feb 27. No actions or decisions.
- i) TIF subcommittee Initial meetings held Jan 31 and Feb 14; subcommittee still in planning phase. No actions or decisions.
- j) Pawcatuck Village Update An update of activity was provided. No actions or decisions.
- k) **Budget Review** Of the \$2,770 budget, about \$2,570 is spent, committed, or authorized-to-spend, leaving a balance-to-spend of about \$200.
- 6. New Business:
  - a) Bikeways Plans: deferred.
  - b) EDC Comprehensive Economic Development Plan: deferred.
- 7. The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
