1. The meeting of the EDC's Liberty Street Subcommittee was called to order at 8:40 a.m.

Continued discussion from February 8 meeting to explore approaches for generating economic development and rehabilitation along sections of Liberty Street to stimulate enhanced value, and vibrant commercial and residential mixed-use neighborhoods in the EDC's information-gathering phase of the project. Next steps include:

  - b. Conduct property inventories, consolidated with valuation data, along sections of Liberty St.
  - c. Develop strawman to contemporize regulation 6.6.14 "rehab of existing buildings for consideration".No decisions were made; a report out and any proposals will be brought to the March Regular EDC meeting for consideration
