## 5. New Business:

**Stone Acres Farm proposed Master Plan for new Agricultural Heritage Zone**: Jane Meiser provided an overview of the Stone Acres project seeking Master Plan approval for the new AHD zone, to go before the PZC on 3/21. The AHD is a planning tool designed to maintain economic viability of farming by expanding potential uses. The proposal maintains Stonington's agricultural heritage, part of the Town's identity, through farming and low-impact commercial uses. **Action:** EDC to send letter of support for project to PZC, Danielle to draft letter (ref: POCD 4.1.1; **Motion**: Blunt White; **Second**: Pete Robinson; **All in Favor** 

- Create a new Heritage Mill District (HM) zone: the HM zone for the Mechanic Street mills area contemporizing uses and streamlining the permit process has been submitted and will be considered by the PZC on April 4. Action: EDC to send letter of support for project to PZC, Blunt to draft letter (ref: POCD 7.2.5, 8.1.4, 10.2.10); Motion: Dave Hammond; Second: Pete Robinson; All in Favor
- Develop a Community Planning Forum series where we bring in thought leaders to talk about "emerging" issues. Expected Outcome: brainstorm list of forum ideas, prioritize and time-phase - deferred
