- 3. Contract Operations Suez (United Water) Jim Nyberg presented the monthly operating report for February, 2017. Current bacteria testing involving the mixing in the UV Channel have shown the mixing seems to be working. All results thus far have been in the required range. Moving forward on the replacement of the transfer switch at Pawcatuck which will not work in the event of a power failure. Replacement should take place in the next two weeks.
- 4. Comments from the Public: Ryan Linaires of Greenskis gave a presentation of their proposal to install solar arrays at the Pawcatuck and Borough facilities. Mr. Linaires made a short power point presentation and answered questions from the Board. This is the last year for incentives through the State of Connecticut. Potential to save \$870,000 over the contract period of 20 years based upon a 3% increase yearly in the cost of purchased electricity. No costs to the WPCA or the Town of Stonington as the all installation costs are covered by Greenskis. No official action was taken by Board.
