July 10, 2017 Minutes (Rodney Johnstone, Acting Secretary)



1. Call to Order:

Chairman Spalding called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Attending were Chairman Spalding, Commissioners Anderson, Degler, Diggs, Johnstone, MacKinnon, O'Neill, , Rose, and Harbormaster Donch and Assistant Harbormaster Estabrooks. Absent: Commissioners: Crites and Smith

2. Minutes:

The Minutes of the June 12, 2017 meeting were reviewed. Acceptance as corrected was moved by Mr. Anderson, seconded by Mr. MacKinnon, and approved unanimously.

3. Stonington Harbor Breakwater renovation

A grant from the State of CT was approved on June 8, 2017 for the rebuilding of the old Stonington Harbor Breakwater. Mr. Diggs will communicate with the Town regarding the status of the Grant.

- A. Slow-No-Wake Zone at Sandy Point: A motion to pursue the installation of slow-no-wake buoys from the Northern tip of Sandy Point from Can Buoy "5" to Can Buoy "7" along the Watch Hill Channel was made by Mr. Diggs, seconded by Mr. Anderson, and approved unanimously.
- B. Extension of Slow-No-Wake in Stonington Harbor: A motion to extend the slow-no-wake zone in Stonington Harbor to a line from the end of Stonington Point to the Eastern end of the West Breakwater was made by Mr. MacKinnon, seconded by Ms. Degler, and defeated by a vote of 3 yeas to 5 nays.
- C. Harbormaster Dock: Mr. Diggs reported that the installation of lights, power, and water at the Harbormaster dock is in process.

8. New Business:

Mr. Diggs will attend the Stonington Police Commission Meeting on July 13 to request greater Police presence in Stonington Harbor for the remainder of the Summer.

Installed a "DANGER – ROCK" buoy on edge of Sandy Point channel. The buoy is installed using a "bottom chain" wrapped around the rock itself. The Helix could not be installed. We have been charged \$1711.70.

Abandoned vessel off Sandy Point: The owner has cleaned up the debris that has washed up on Sandy Point. U.S. F&W is not requiring the owner to remove the rest of the vessel. He is to walk the island again a couple times this summer and make sure all is cleaned up.
