

# Stonington Harbor Management Commission Monthly Meeting September 12, 2016 Final Minutes (Sherman Crites, Acting Secretary)



#### 1. Call to Order:

Chairman Spalding called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Attending were Chairman Spalding, Commissioners Anderson, MacKinnon, O'Neill, Johnstone, Crites, Smith, Diggs, Rose, and Assistant Harbormaster Estabrooks. Absent: Harbormaster Donch.

#### 2. Minutes:

The Minutes of the August 15, 2016 meeting were reviewed and amended. Acceptance as amended was moved by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. O'Neill, and approved unanimously.

#### 5. Treasurer's Report:

The Financial Report for August is attached. It was reviewed. Mr. Crites noted that it was unlikely the number of moorings permitted in 2016 will greatly exceed those actually placed in 2015, and that we will end the year with all bills paid, and a small surplus.

Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report was moved by Mr. Anderson, seconded by Mr. Smith, and approved unanimously.

#### 6. Harbormaster's Report:

The Report for August is attached and was discussed. Further discussion included the following:

In order to help prepare the next set of wait listers for a possible mooring in 2017, Mr. Diggs will draft a letter, for review at our next meeting, to be sent immediately thereafter, suggesting "you may be offered a mooring next spring..." to allow for wait lister preparation.

In conjunction with the need to mark and subsequently remove a large rock just off the Sandy Point channel that has become a hazard to navigation, Mr. Johnston again urged the channel

be moved to the eastern end of Sandy Point. There seems to be support for this from boaters on the Pawcatuck River, Westerly and Watch Hill.

How we will conduct the September mandated Wait List update (by post, email, or otherwise) is uncertain and awaits direction from the Harbormaster.

Acceptance of the Report was moved by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Anderson and approved unanimously.
