

BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS
September 17, 2016

The Board of Assessment Appeals met on Saturday, September 17, 2016 to hear appeals on the 2015 motor vehicle Grand List. Members present were Stephen Palmer, Betty Richards and David Harma. The meeting was called to order at 9:09 a.m.

The following appeals were heard:

Adler, Arnold – 1997 Mercedes-Benz ID# WDBFA63FXVF145799

Mr. Adler paid \$2,500 for the vehicle last year. The transmission only has drive and reverse. The dashboard lights don't work and the top does not go down. The vehicle needs a lot of work. Stephen Palmer and David Harma inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$2,975.

King, Stephen – 1972 Oldsmobile 442 ID# 3J67M2M176137

Mr. King was represented by his daughter Gina King. Mr. King filed an antique affidavit on August 19, 2016. He filed an affidavit in the town the vehicle was previously registered but he did not realize that he had to file the affidavit in Stonington when he moved.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to deny the petition.

Denard, John T. – 2006 Chevy Silverado ID# 2GCEK13V161242774

Mr. Denard paid \$8,800 for the truck on March 7, 2015. The Silverado is a LS; not a LT. It has over 200,000 miles. Stephen Palmer and David Harma inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$7,650.

The Board voted unanimously to accept the minutes for the April 19, 2016 meeting as read.

After a discussion, the Board agreed unanimously to include reasons for denials on the October 1, 2016 decision notices on a one year trail basis.

There being no appeals, the meeting was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
