- Maintenance/Repairs – Work ongoing at Seawell building. Members discussed the unlikely event that SNEFLA would receive the FEMA reimbursement from the storm. All employees involved from the Town no longer work in Stonington.
- Donahue Park – No changes
- Traffic line painting – Lines are down but signs haven't been installed yet

Members discussed the kayaks that have been stolen from the Small Boat Association area this season. Also discussed, the abandoned boat in the flats (Westerly waters) at Sandy Point.
