

BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS

The following appeals were heard. All decisions were voted on by Board members Stephen Palmer, Karen O'Keefe and Gisela Harma.

Nemser, Selina – 2007 Chev. Malibu ID# 1G1ZT57NX7F185512

Decision: After inspecting the vehicle, the Board voted unanimously to deny the petition.

Nemser, Selina - 2012 Subaru Legacy ID# 4S3BMBC61C3014226

Decision: After inspecting the vehicle, the Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$ 4,380.

Palmer, Mary – 2002 Subaru ID# 4S3BH806727605485 represented by Kyle Palmer.

Decision: The Board voted to take no action. This appeal is an unregistered motor vehicle taxed as personal property for the 2018 and 2019 grand lists. The Board noted they do not have the authority to adjust the assessment at this meeting.

Ms. Elliott submitted pictures of the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$ 4,360.

Ventura, Maria – 2012 Toyota Rav4 ID# JTMRK4DV4C5109471


Decision: After inspecting the vehicle, the Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$ 7,740.
