The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) has been conducting a legislative study to investigate the feasibility of and market for:

Extending the Shore Line East rail service to the State of Rhode Island

1) Establishing a new passenger rail service from the City of New London to the City of Norwich

Establishing a new passenger train station in the Town of Groton and Stonington Borough

Extending bus services in southeastern CT and providing connectivity between such services and rail lines
