April 21, 2015

First Selectman George Crouse, Jr., reconvened the Special Town Meeting of April 13, 2015, adjourned to this date at 8:30 p.m. at the Stonington Town Hall.

Hearing no objection, the First Selectman dispensed with reading the call, which is recorded on the preceding page.

First Selectman Crouse read the results of the referendum vote on the question:

**"Shall the Town of Stonington appropriate and bond \$69,000,000 for evaluating, planning, designing, repairing, equipping, improving, modifying, renovating and constructing property at the Town's West Vine Street School, Deans Mill School and Pawcatuck Middle School?"**


First Selectman Crouse declared the question approved.
