- Updates to the July draft meeting minutes
- Discussion on recruitment for additional members – suggestions include newspaper, online and word of mouth and what is the open space available in group.
- Report on Tom Norris's resignation from Climate Change Task Force
- Alisa Morrison presented on methods that GIS can be utilized to assess Study Area #1. This information included the overlaying of town data with federal and state resources. Presentation discussed potential new roads and lot lines and number of lots, buildings and parcels lost. Additional tools are available for property, goods and personal lost when information by town assessment and census are incorporated.
