

**BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS**  
**September 12, 2015**

The Board of Assessment Appeals met on Saturday, September 12, 2015 to hear appeals on the 2014 motor vehicle Grand List. Members present were Stephen Palmer, Betty Richards and David Harma. The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m.

The following appeals were heard:

Murphy, James – 1996 VW Passat

Mr. Murphy purchased the vehicle for \$500 at private sale. It has 342,000 miles and is in need of some repairs.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to change the assessment to \$700.

Moody, Patricia – 1999 Nomad Trailer

Ms. Moody has a 24' travel trailer model number 249LT purchased in 2006. She spoke with a RV retail dealer and was told the values in the NADA books are too high. He feels the books are in error because multiple models in multiple years all have the same value listed. He feels the assessment should be around \$2,000.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to change the assessment to \$2,000.

Journey, Erin – 2002 Itasca camper

Ms. Journey stated that she paid \$9,000 for the camper. It had been parked and not used for a long time. It had a lot of water damage and tire rot. When purchased, there were rat nests in the engine and the air conditioning system. The camper is a Spirit series 24V RB.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to change the assessment to \$8,470.

Stewart, Bonnie – 2006 Volvo V70

Ms. Stewart pointed out the difference in value when comparing the Kelley Blue Book and the NADA book. This vehicle has over 200,000 miles. She purchased the vehicle in October 2013 for \$5,250.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to change the assessment to \$5,400.

The Board voted unanimously to accept the minutes for the April 21, 2015 meeting as read.

There being no appeals, the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
