New Mooring permits issued: 0 Moorings given up (YTD): 15

New Mooring assignments in the works: 1

Deposits to SHMC account since last report: \$450 2022 YTD = \$26,065

Mooring renewals: 283 renewals sent out 288 approved, 1 under review

USCG Temporary buoy between "G 5" and "G 7" along Sandy point channel appears to be placed too far into the channel. USCG ATON Group will look at moving or removing that buoy. No Update

There appears to be significant shoaling in Sandy Point channel near "G 7". Seatow and Tow Boat both report multiple soft groundings at low tides in this area.

SNW buoys installed around Sandy Point. No update from CT DEEP about permit approval signatures.

Requested Dodson's to install the Red/Green channel markers in upper harbor.

S/V Maiden (see details in this year's newsletter) will be arriving in Stonington Harbor on July 19 at 1600. SHYC will host at their dock. A flotilla is being organized to meet Maiden outside the harbor, in the area of White Rock, to escort her in.
